



USGA RULES GOVERN ALL PLAY
Unless Modified by Local Rules as Follows:

- White stakes of lines define out of bounds on Holes 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 16, 17, and 18. Roads, including the parking lot, define out of bounds on Holes 1, 2, 7, 8, 10, and 18.
- Red or yellow stakes define all penalty areas.
- Hole 4 - Drainage ditches in the general area cut to fairway height or less are considered ground under repair. Free relief may be taken under Rule 16.1b.
- Hole 9 - For a ball in the yellow penalty area, the dropping zone located near the bridge may be used as an extra relief option for one penalty stroke.
- Hole 11 - The water is played as a yellow penalty area from the tee. Once the ball comes to rest on the island, the water is played as a red penalty area. A provisional ball may be played for a possible ball in the yellow penalty area.
- Model Local Rule E-5 is in effect for general play (Alternative to Stroke and Distance for Lost Ball or Ball Out of Bounds).
